Will of Henry Aukward of City of Washington, D.C. (dtd. Jan. 15, 1842, probated Apr. 29, 1842)

To wife, during her natural life, all property; in case of wife's death or marriage, to niece Elizabeth Bennett, brick house I now occupy, situated on L St. S., with ground on which it stands, also all ground east thereof adjoining said house and lot belonging to me; should Elizabeth die without issue, property to be divided between her two sisters, Emma Bartley and Virginia Bartley to share alike; remaining portion of real estate on L St. S. to nephew William Jones, son of John Jones, and at his death to be divided between his sister or sisters who may be living at the time; the west half to be the property of the heirs of James Davis and my niece Mary Ann Davis, his wife.

In the event of either of the begatees named shall directly or indirectly sell or cause to suffer to be sold on any part of the property devised any spiritous or malt liquor (after being three times admonished against such conduct or impropriety of selling) by my Exr. or any prudent and discreet persons ... they do forfeit all interest and title to said property so devised ... and the same is hereby devised to the three trustees of the Methodist Protestant Church, East Washington Station.

Funeral of Joseph H. Aukward

Was for Thirty Years Employed at Hospital for the Insane

Joseph H. Aukward, who died Monday evening at his residence, No. 128 D street southeast, aged sixty-two years, had been an employee of the Government Hospital for the Insane for thirty years past. He was connected with the construction force in the capacity of foreman and had been engaged in many of the building projects at the institution for some years. He was the contractor for the main dining hall built adjacent to the detached buildings, which he erected during a suspension of the regular work of the hospital. He was at one time employed at the Bloomingdale Hospital, in New York.

His funeral, which was largely attended, was held this morning from St. Peter's Church on Capitol Hill, where requiem high mass was offered at 9:30 o'clock. The interment was made in a local cemetery. Mr. Aukward had been absent from his duties at the hospital for a number of weeks, but his demise was a cause of surprise and regret to his associates and friends.
