Axe. At 6 o'clock a.m. Tuesday, July 24, 1877, after a lingering and painful illness, which he bore with Christian fortitude and resignation, John C. Axe, in the 51st year of his age. A good citizen, a kind father, and a faithful friend, he was always foremost in every good work. He labored here for the good of others, and has gone to his reward. The Funeral of the late John C. Axe took place yesterday, and was very largely attended. The remains were taken to the 4th street M.E. church, where the services were conducted by the pastor, Rev. B.G.W. Reid, after which they were taken to the Congressional cemetery, where the interment was made. Harmony Lodge, No. 9, I.O.O.F.; Franklin Lodge, No. 2, K. of P.; Washington Circle, No. 3, B.U. (H.F.) C.A.; Eagle Tent of Rechabites, Eagle Tent of Junior Rechabites, and Washington Lodge of Mechanics followed the remains to the grave, where the services of the orders were performed by the chaplains.
