Death of an Old Citizen

Mr. Jeremiah Hepburn, one of the oldest citizens of Washington, died this morning at his late residence, on 19th street, of heart disease, in the seventy-second year of his age. Mr. Hepburn had resided in this city nearly all his life, and for many years in South Washington. For a number of years he served in the capacity of clerk under the city government, most of the time in the tax collector's office. He was an excellent clerk, peculiarly well fitted for the positions he held, and was one of our best citizens. He was a prominent member of the orders of Odd Fellows and Masons, who will attend his funeral on Sunday afternoon.
