Miss Mollie McDonough, of Charleston, Va., who was arrested in that place about three months ago by the military authorities, upon the charge of being connected with the murder of Capt. E.M. Buchanan, who was killed in that place on the 27th of September, died in the Old Capitol Prison yesterday, of typhoid fever. John A. McDonough, who was arrested as the principal in the murder, is still in the Old Capitol.

The body of Miss McDonough, who died in the Old Capitol on Sunday, of typhoid fever as we stated yesterday was placed in a handsome coffin furnished by the Government and was buried at 3 p.m. yesterday in the Congressional Cemetery. The deceased is a niece of Rev. James McDonough in this city, who early fled from Leesburg, Va., a Union refugee to Washington.
