Frederick . Price, 76, of 631 G street S.E., a retired draftsman of the Post Office Department, died yesterday in Wilmington, Del., where he was visiting his son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. James H. Cassidy. He had been ill for some time.			
Mr. Price was president of the St. Vincent de Paul Society of St. Peter's Catholic Church here He had belonged to the society for more than 50 years, was a charter member of Carroll Council, Knights of Columbus, and treasurer of the National Union Council, No. 200. Mr. Price was retired from the Government, in 1932 after 48 years' service.			
Besides his daughter, Mr. Price leaves a son, Frederick M. Price, jr., this city; three other daughters, Miss Julia A. Price, this city; Mrs. William McCuen, Alexandria,Va., and Mrs. John T. McGarry, Parma, Ohio, and eight grandchildren.			
Funeral services will be held at 9 a.m. tomorrow in St. Peter's Catholic Church, following brief services at Mr. Price's late residence. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.

Yesterday afternoon Mrs. F. Price, who resided at No. 476 G street southwest, started to enter the shoe store of George W. Rich, on Market space, when she remarked that she felt as though she would faint and asked to be given something quickly. Mr. Columbus, one of the clerks, was standing at the door at the time and before he had fully realized the lady's request she reeled and fell to the pavement. A gentleman who stood near the window at the time caught Mrs. Price as she fell and prevented her from being injured. Dr. J.M. Price, a nephew of the sick lady, was in the neighborhood at the time and he administered to his aunt, but medical assistance was without avail. Mrs. Price expired in a few minutes Miss Crollard was in the store at the time and assisted the dying woman as best she could, but the excitement was more than she could bear. She became hysterical and had to be sent home. Mrs. Price, who was apparently if woman fifty years old, had suffered for several years from heart trouble, and that was no doubt the cause of her death. Her body was removed to her late home by the police.
