Roux, Charles <i>The Evening Star, November 24, 1858</i> <i>Death By Poison</i> Yesterday morning, a man named Rue or Roux died, suddenly at an Italian boarding house in the Fifth Ward. Our information, received from an officer, is, that the evening previous he took laudanum, which caused his death. We have not been able to ascertain whether it was taken purposely to commit suicide but it was generally supposed that it was.
