*Little Boy Dies of Burns*

*Six-Year-Old Albert F. Snyder Was Playing Indian Near Brush Fire*

Albert F. Snyder, the six-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. A.F. Snyder of Clarendon, Va., died Thursday night at his parents' home of burns received Wednesday while playing Indian.

The boy donned his Indian suit yesterday morning. He was but a short distance from his home when he built a small brush fire. He was standing near the flames when his clothing caught fire. He screamed for help and started to run toward his home. The wind fanned the flames and soon he was a blazing torch from head to foot. A neighbor extinguished the flames and took the boy to his home. Dr. Ralph Quick was summoned and endeavored to save the lad, but he died about midnight.

The funeral was held this afternoon at the Methodist Episcopal Church, South Clarendon, Va. Rev. F.M. Swann conducted the services. Interment was made in Congressional cemetery.

<i>The Evening Star, April 23, 1914, p. 11</i> <i>Miss Snyder's Death From Heart Disease</i> <i>Verdict in the Inquest Over Woman Who Died in Dental Office</i> An inquest held at police headquarters yesterday afternoon in the case of Miss Wilhelmina Snyder, fifty years old, who died in a dental establishment resulted in a verdict of death from heart disease.  Mrs. A.M. McFarland, a niece of Miss Snyder, was with her aunt in the dentist's office yesterday. It was testified that Miss Snyder asked that all her teeth, about fifteen, be extracted, but the dentist would only extract five of them yesterday. He administered a small quantity of a weak solution of cocaine, he stated, but it was not enough to affect Miss Snyder.  It was not until after the teeth had been extracted that Miss Snyder complained of being sick. She died a few minutes after a physician reached her. The autopsy, it was testified, showed that Miss Snyder had heart disease.
