*Born in Prince Georges County, Md., Eighty-Nine Years Ago*

Mrs. Sarah Antoinette Suit died at the home of her granddaughter, Mrs. George L. Dietz of 49 Florida avenue northwest, today in the eighty-ninth year of her age. Funeral services have not been arranged.

Mrs. Suit was a native of Prince Georges county, Md., but had made her home in this city during the last quarter of a century. Death came as the result of general debility. She had been confined to her bed for about a month.

She was a member of the Methodist Church. Two daughters, Mrs. Sarah E. Hopkins, who has been employed at the government printing office for twenty years: Mrs. Fannie Hopkins and a son William H. Suit, all of this city, survive her.
